Frequently Asked Questions – FAQ's

TEAM REGISTRATION

Question: Where can I obtain my Cal South Member Account username and password?

Answer: You can contact your league/club registrar and they should be able to provide your username and password. You may also use this link to request your username and password:

Question: Are the 2006/14U playing in the State Cup Olders or Youngers Division?

Answer: 2006/14U are in the Youngers Division in 2020. The overall majority of 2004 players are in 8th grade and not in High School.

Question: The State Tournament Play Level Guide recommends that I play in the Presidents Division. Can I play up in the National Cup Division?

Answer: Yes, Teams can play up in a higher division at their own discretion.

Question: My team is not doing that well in league play, should I apply to a lower division?

Answer: No, first register for the Division outlined in the State Tournament Play Level Guide. You may then appeal to play down a division after you complete your application. Please review the Appeal Process posted on State Cup website.

Question: I started the online application but did not finish. Can I go back and complete the application?

Answer: Yes. You can login anytime to complete your online application. Please keep in mind the deadline dates. Make sure you click on the SUBMIT APPLICATION tab at the end to complete the application process.

Question: Where do I send our team entry fee payment?

Answer: Submit payment by credit card during the online application process or mail your team entry fee by check to: Cal South – 2020 State Cup, 1029 S. Placentia Avenue, Fullerton, CA 92831. Please include your payment summary coupon along with check and team ID number in the check memo. Question: Do we need players and coaches' photos on the team roster?

Answer: Yes. Please contact your registrar so they can upload current photos of all your team players and coaches.

Question: Do we need to upload player jersey numbers on the application/team roster?

Answer: Yes. The team manager can upload jersey numbers online. Jersey Numbers are required now for identifying players for our ODP Program and for College Coaches who come out to your games.

RULES AND COMPETITIONS

Question: Is heading allowed for 2009/11U, 2010/10U and 2011/9U age groups?

Answer: No heading is not allowed for these age groups. Heading starts with the 2008/12U age group.

Question: What age groups will have the US Soccer PDI build out line on the field?

Answer: The 2020/10U and 2011/9U age groups will have a build out line.

Question: Are State Cup games played on holidays and Super Bowl Weekend?

Answer: Yes, we play on Mother's Day and Super Bowl Weekend. We do not play on Easter Sunday.

Question: If a player played with team all Fall Season is he/she eligible to play in State Cup?

Answer: Yes, as long as the player is properly rostered on the CAL SOUTH Fall Season Team Roster. Other league and Spring Season team rosters do not fulfill this requirement.

Question: When is the tournament Roster Freeze deadline?

Answer: Three (3) days prior to the start of the competition for each age group. All players appearing on a team rostered cannot be transferred to another team after this Wednesday, 6pm deadline. Players released after this deadline are considered Ineligible and may not participate with another State Tournament team. The player's parent must initiate the online Player Release process a minimum of 9 days prior to the Roster Freeze deadline.

Question: What happened to the Cup Tie Rule for Presidents and Nationals Cup?

Answer: We no longer have the Cup Tie Rule in Presidents and National Cup?

Question: When is the player/team Cup Tie deadline?

Answer: Please view the time chart for each division.

Question: Are referee fees included in the Cal South State Cup registration fee?

Answer: No. Referees fees are separate from the entry fee. You will find the information in the Manager Central Section.

Question: What are the State Cup Awards/Prizes?

Answer: Champions and Finalists teams receive a team trophy and individual player/coach medals. In certain age groups and divisions, the State Cup Champion advances to USYS Regional competition. Advancing team receives a financial travel subsidy award from Cal South to attend regional and national competitions.

Question: Where can I locate the 2020 Cal South State Cup Rules?

LOCATIONS AND VENUES

Question: Where are State Cups games played?

Answer: Games will be hosted at various soccer facilities and complexes throughout Southern California. Locations will be posted along with the game schedule approximately 30 days prior to the start of the competition for each respective age group.
