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Compliance	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Team Administrators (TA) (Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Team Manager, Referees): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) All NEW TA must complete the course. b) Required for Team Rostering, Team Activation and TA Card Printing beginning June 1, 2020 c) All TA rostered to a Team must meet the requirement before the Team can be activated. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) Team Activation beginning May 29, 2020 d) Required for Team Rostering after Team has been activated 2) Parents and/or Guardians and players <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Must acknowledge the receipt of the SCA sheet from the League/Club. 3) League/Club <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Must have received the signed acknowledgement that the Parent/Guardian received SCA sheet. b) L/C must confirm on the Player Profile that the Parent/Guardian has received the SCA sheet.
Online System Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Team Administrators (TA) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Cal South Registration System (CSRS) will not allow TAs (Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Team Managers, et..) cards to be printed unless the compliance requirements have been met. b) The CSRS TA profile will provide for the acknowledgment of the successful completion of the required course and the upload of the certificate. c) The CSRS will allow for the upload of the certificate provided by successfully completing the SCA course. 2) Parents <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) The CSRS will provide through the Parent/Guardian account the function to download and acknowledge the receipt of the SCA sheet through the ELA. b) The L/C will have the capability on the CSRS to acknowledge the “hard copy” receipt from the parent/guardian that the parent/guardian has received the SCA sheet through the ELA. c) The CSOS will not allow the player card to be printed unless the receipt acknowledgement has been confirmed.

Athlete	1) Optional
Parents	1) Parents/Guardians must acknowledge the receipt of the SCA sheet from the League/Club. 2) The CSRS will provide through the Parent/Guardian account the function to download and acknowledge the receipt of the SCA sheet. 3) The L/C will have the capability on the CSRS to acknowledge the “hard copy” receipt from the parent/guardian that the parent/guardian has received the SCA sheet. 4) The CSRS will not allow the player card to be printed unless the receipt acknowledgement has been confirmed.
Volunteer	1) Optional, if rostering to a team is not necessary, i.e. snack bar volunteer
