



Sanctioned Tournaments Use of International Referees

The SRC recognizes that many prestigious tournaments request that International Referees, as defined below, be assigned. This policy permits this under the following terms and conditions:

1. The International Referees must be currently registered and in good standing in their home country or federation.
2. The Tournament must be sanctioned by Cal South.
3. The Tournament must have a Cal South Referee Agreement with a SRC approved local referee association ("Association"), and the referee assignor must be currently registered with Cal South as a U.S. Soccer assignor.
4. The Association must maintain a policy of general liability insurance (in addition to any insurance coverage provided through US Soccer) with coverage not less than \$1,000,000 (each occurrence) and \$5,000,000 (general aggregate).
5. International Referee means a referee registered by a federation other than U.S. Soccer. The policy permits an International Referee to be assigned to one tournament during the calendar year. Any International Referee who seeks other, regular or general assignments to referee matches within Cal South must register and meet the requirements as a referee under the U.S. Soccer Federation.
